## Port Huron

To comply with social distancing, we will place the meals on a cart, which is disinfected between cars, wheel it to your vehicle in which you may receive the meals through your window. If this is not possible, you may open your trunk; we will place the food in there for you. Otherwise, we ask that you come and load your vehicle with the meals on the cart.

Anyone can come and pick up meals for children. Children are not required to be with adults.

Times and locations may be adjusted as needed. Any changes will be communicated through social media and Skylert messaging. If you are unable to pick up at the distribution sites you may have a neighbor or friend pick them up for you.
