Get Care at Home Instead of a Nursing Home

Nursing homes are not the only choice for people who need help caring for themselves. The MI Choice Medicaid Waiver Program can allow you or your loved one to get care services at home instead.

What Kind of Care Can You Receive?

The program can assist with activities like bathing, dressing, meal preparation, personal care, and toileting. Complex nursing care, transportation, and respite care may also be provided. All services are paid for through the program, and there will be no cost for you or your loved one. You can get care at a private home or in a participating senior living facility.



Do You Qualify for the Program?

To qualify, you must:

- ✓ Be 65 or older or be an adult with a disability
- ✓ Need a nursing home level of care
- ✓ Meet financial eligibility

Financial Eligibility

You cannot have more than \$9,660 in assets, and there is a monthly income limit as well. In 2025, that limit is \$2,901. It's important to note that not all your assets are considered. Your home and car won't be counted. If you are married, your assets will be looked at differently.

Statewide Program

The program is funded by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services and is available throughout Michigan. AgeWays provides MI Choice services in Livingston, Macomb, Monroe, Oakland, St. Clair, and Washtenaw counties.

Getting Started

Start by calling us at **800-852-7795**. We'll ask some initial screening questions to see if you might qualify. If so, we will get you started on the next steps. We will need to do a care assessment to confirm eligibility and also make sure you meet financial requirements before you can be enrolled. Once you are enrolled, we will work with you to understand your needs, develop a plan of care and put services in place.
